pag. 19 — "Up to the present year, all the continental nations had paid duties of 24 per cent. on their imports, whilst English commodities were subjected to a duty of 15 only. The measure in question, which was consequently prejudicial to English commerce, yet unquestionably called for the interests of Brazil; and the entire speech of Vasconcellos was at once a master-piece of sound reasoning, of perspicuity, and of economic science."
